ARRIVAL INFORMATION

All competitors are required to arrive on site between Noon and 5:00PM on Wednesday 26th

Upon arrival, please drive up the main Estate drive, where you will be met by our volunteers. You will then be provided with a pitch card and parked in your pre-determined designated pitches. Please follow all instructions when parking. Once parked up, please go to the Stable Manager's Office without your horse, where you will be welcomed and allocated stables. You will then be invited to present your horse for inspection by the Vet (please bring your horses' passport).

Rider packs will be available from Secretaries from 4PM onwards. This will include, car passes for the duration of the event (one per competitor), wristbands for the stabling area, finalised timetable, hacking route plan, bridal numbers, Competitor polo shirts (if pre-ordered) and site plan.

The Riders' Briefing will commence at 6PM prompt. All competitors must attend. Our Bar and food retailer outlets will be open from 5PM.

TIMETABLE

The timetable attached to this document is PROVISIONAL only. A finalised timetable will be provided at the rider briefing and may be updated during the Event as required.

LORRY PARKING & HOOK UPS

Hook ups must be ordered by 6PM on 20th July 2018 either on BDWP or on the stable booking form. After this date no hookup bookings will be accepted or refunds provided.

Upon arrival you will be allocated a card which will also show whether you have booked hookup or not and identify your pitch. This card must be kept in your vehicle's windscreen at all times. If an U18 competitor, we will endeavour to allocate you a pitch close to fellow competitors from your regions, albeit this cannot be guaranteed.

Once parked in your pitch, **DO NOT** move your vehicle to another pitch and **DO NOT** help yourself to hookups. If a competitor's vehicle is moved and/or is connected to a hookup without permission, that competitor will be required to leave the competition without refund.

There will be space in front of each pitch for a small tent or gazebo. The Organisers retain the discretion to ask for any tents / gazebos to be removed if considered to raise a potential health and safety risk.

For 2018 we have made a significant investment in constructing an exit road at the bottom of the lorry park, widened access roads and the leveling of ground to permit the removal of lorries in the event of adverse weather conditions. Given that the event is taking place in July, adverse weather is a real possibility. If this occurs, please be patient as we remove vehicles in a safe manner and please ensure that you have towing eyes with your vehicle. All towing is done at owner's risk, so if you do not wish to be towed out, please state so.

VACCINATION CERTIFICATES & PASSPORTS

CCI* - All horses must have the relevant up to date vaccinations and passports as per **FEI Rules**. All passports will be checked and random vet checks carried out.

BE100u18 Championship - All horses must have the relevant up to date vaccinations and passports as per **BE Rules**. All passports will be checked and random vet checks carried out.

STABLING

Access to the stables will only be available to individuals wearing a Stable Pass.

PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOU LEAVE YOUR STABLE MUCK-FREE – and use the areas provided as Muck Heaps. Stables will be inspected on departure. Any stable left inappropriately, the rider will be charged £30, proceeds to charity.

Snowflake Standard Bedding (£8) and haylage (£9) can be purchased from the stable manager's office if required. 2 bales of Snowflake Standard Bedding are allocated per stable on arrival.

There is NO penning available.

Access to the stables will be permitted during the night, but the Night Book **MUST** be completed.

IMPORTANT – The majority of Event stables have full metal grills. You are therefore advised to bring a stable door chain.

Horse showers will be available throughout the duration of the event. Ice will be available to purchase on Saturday next to the Stable Manager's Office.

TROT-UPS

Trot-ups will take place for CCI* competitors only and will commence at 8AM on Thursday 26th and 10AM on Sunday 29th, in the courtyard. See finalised timetable for further details.

RESTAURANT

Booking for our on-site restaurant is essential as it completely sold out for every night in 2017. Menus attached. Please book at www.frickleypark.co.uk.

USE OF THE ESTATE

We are privileged to be allowed to use the Frickley Estate. Please make sure that you keep the area around your horsebox and stable tidy and put **ALL** rubbish in the bins provided.

Dogs are welcome, but must be kept on leads at all times (including in the stabling area, lorry park and parkland). The Estate is a working farm, with livestock on site. The owners of any loose dog will be fined £30, proceeds to charity.

No quad bikes, mopeds or similar are permitted anywhere on the Frickley Estate. No bicycles are permitted within the stable area.

FIRE PRECAUTIONS

In the event of fire please inform an Official immediately. Campfires are not permitted anywhere on the Frickley Estate, this includes any BBQs (including disposals) which are in direct contact with the ground.

DISABLED PARKING

Disabled Parking – will be available on presentation of a Registered Disabled Person's Car Badge

EXERCISING / WARMING UP

All horses stabled on site **MUST** wear head collars and their number at all times when outside of their stable.

Whilst doing any exercising and/or warming up, BE/FEI competition rules regarding saddlery and equipment apply at all times. Please be aware of those competing around you and stay within the designated areas. Please use the roped-off Horse Walks – **WALKING PACE ONLY**.

Competitors will be required to wear the correct hat at all times to BE standards. All hats must be tagged.

Hacking – The Estate has kindly opened up a 3 mile hack (no public roads) for use by competitors. Details available in Rider Packs and at the Stable Manager's Office. All hacks must consist of at least three riders, who must carry with them at least one mobile phone. Everyone going on the hack must inform the Stable Managers when they heading off, in case of accidents.

Exercising – The field used for the national class dressage warm up will be available for exercising horses.

Showjumping/XC Practice – A field has been allocated for SJ and XC practice at specified time. Please see the timetable. Details from the Stable Manager's Office. This facility can only be used within the specified time periods.

Arena Familiarisation – Please see the finalised timetable for specified time periods. Stay in walk at all times, do not enter the dressage arenas (i.e. remain on the outside of the boards) and walk in the same direction as fellow riders.

Collecting Rings – These are only for use by competitors who are about to complete a phase of their class. They are not available for general exercising.

Lungeing – Will only be allowed in the allocated area.

CROSS COUNTRY COURSE WALKS

The XC Courses will only be formally approved on the evening of Wednesday 25th July. After which they may be walked by competitors and others, on foot. Dogs to be kept on leads at all times. See Secretaries/Programme for map of the course.

PRIZE GIVINGS

These will take place on Sunday 29th July.

The BE100 U18 and the CCI* prize givings will take place separately from each other, after the completion of their respective showjumping elements. Hence, the BE100 U18 prize-giving will take place at approximately noon, the CCIJ* U18 at 3PM and the CCIY* at 5PM.

Individual prize giving will be mounted and will take place immediately after the final round of show jumping for each class.

The team prize giving for each class will then follow on foot in the International Arena, using our podium, for teams placed 1st to 3rd. Prize giving for teams placed 4th to 8th will then take place immediately afterwards in the Main Marquee.

Please dress accordingly and follow Stewards' directions at all times so that we can keep everything running smoothly and within timetable.

LEGAL LIABILITY

Frickley Park Limited will not be held responsible for any accident, damage or loss (other than personal injury) to anyone attending the event unless caused by the gross negligence of the Organisers. Please take care around all horses.

VETERINARY, FARRIER & MEDICAL CARE

A Vet will be on-site during competition hours and on call at all times. Please contact the Secretaries Office or the Stable Managers Office. All treatment must be paid for.

A farrier will be available during competition hours. All work must be paid for.

A team of doctors and paramedic units will be on-site during competition hours. Please contact the Stable Manager's Office or any official with a radio if required. A First Aider will be available over night and for other emergencies, phone numbers will be available at the Stable Managers office.

PHOTOGRAPHIC RIGHTS

All competitors and their parents/guardians give permission for any photographs/videos/other images taken by press/outside agencies/official photographers at Frickley Park to be published in the press and on the internet for publicity purposes and any official publication. Frickley Park will select photographs for publication with care and respect for those shown.

ENTERTAINMENT

Masterclass – We are hosting a Masterclass on Thursday evening (jumping) in the National Arena.

Entertainment – Entertainment will be provided on Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights in the Main Marquee. This will include music and competitor games.

Bar – The Bar will be open Noon to 10.30PM Thursday to Saturday night. Please drink moderately (and responsibly)!

CAMP SITE

We are providing a camp site in a field adjacent to the XC start – this is a new location for 2018 to provide more necessary space. Please contact Kelly if you wish to book a pitch.

Small gazebos will be permitted in the lorry park **IN FRONT** of vehicles, but not at the side. This is again for health and safety reasons, so that we can access vehicles in case of emergencies.
